Job Description for Direct Care Staff / Aide

Qualifications and Education Requirement:

- 18 years of age and older, Background Clearance, Drug Screening, Physical exam w/ TB Clearance, Reliable, Have Patience, Caring, Responsible, & Trustworthy
- High School Diploma or equivalent, Skills Evaluation, First Aid/ CPR Certified or ability to complete courses, Must be able to lift fifty (50) pounds
- 1 year Experience working in the capacity of a caregiver or willing to complete 20 hours of continuing education to gain knowledge
- Able to work in the US

Duties and responsibilities:

Primarily provide overall care, safety, and supervision which includes but is not limited to:

- Assisting consumers with personal care (ADLs)
- Assist with personal hygiene as necessary
- Monitor the participants for signs and symptoms of illness
- Escort participants to hospital in the event of an emergency and speak clearly to emergency personnel
- Light cleaning in compliance with the facilities requirements
- Provide classroom & community-based education/training to participants
